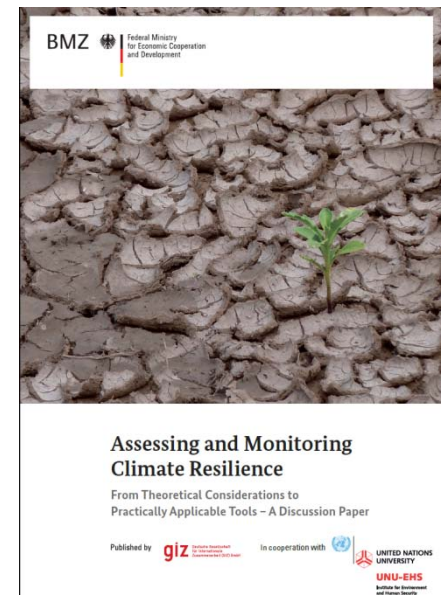
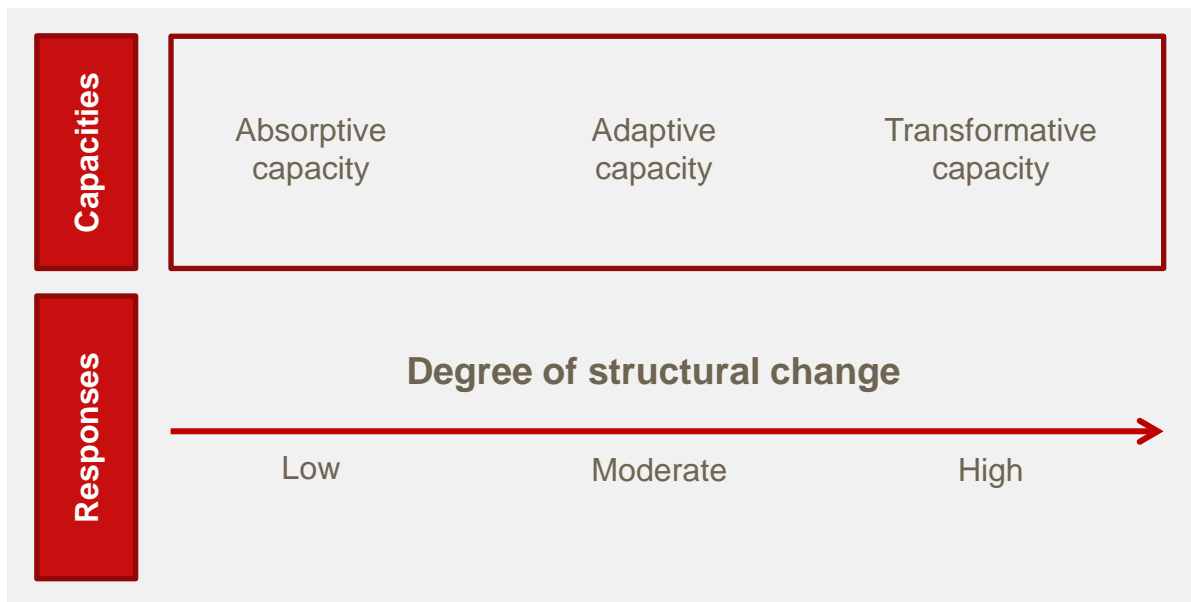

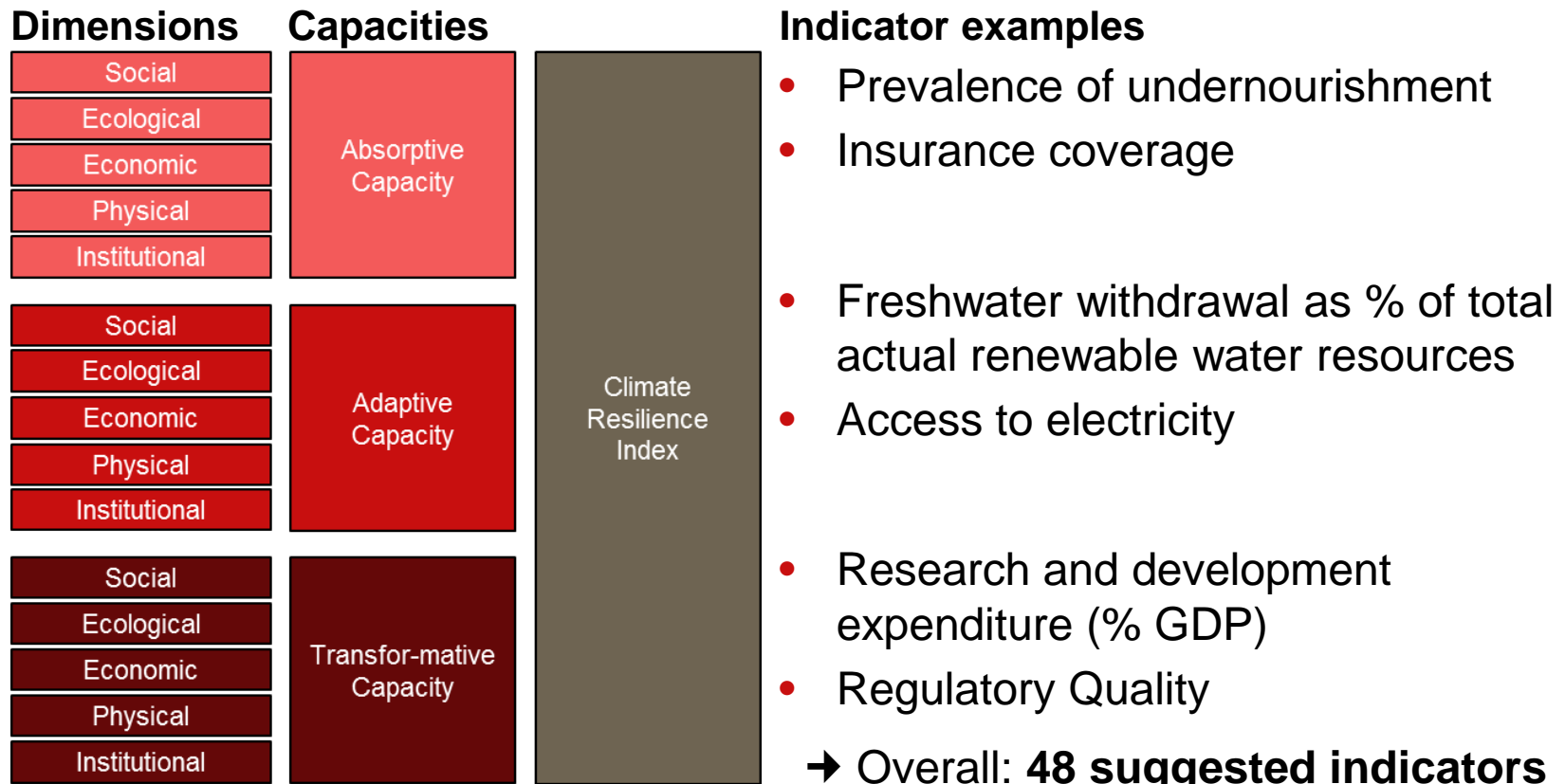
Climate Resilience: Definition and concept

Ability to absorb and recover from climatic shocks and stresses, whilst positively adapting and transforming structures and means for living in the face of long-term change and uncertainty.





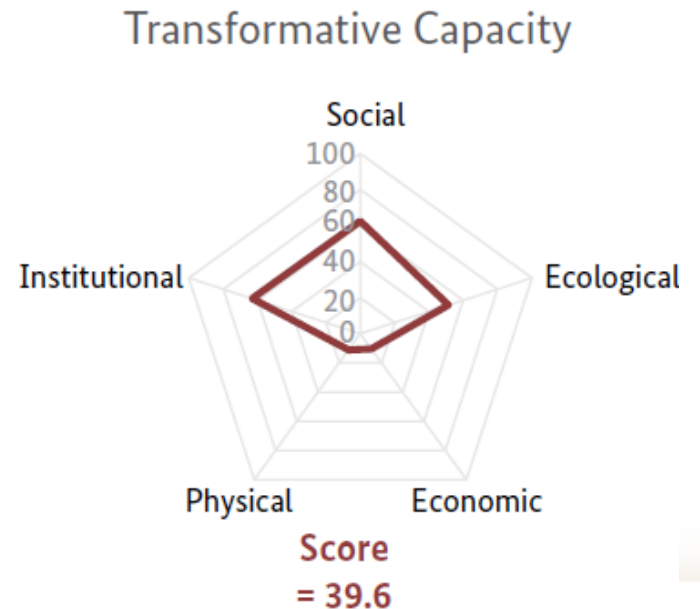
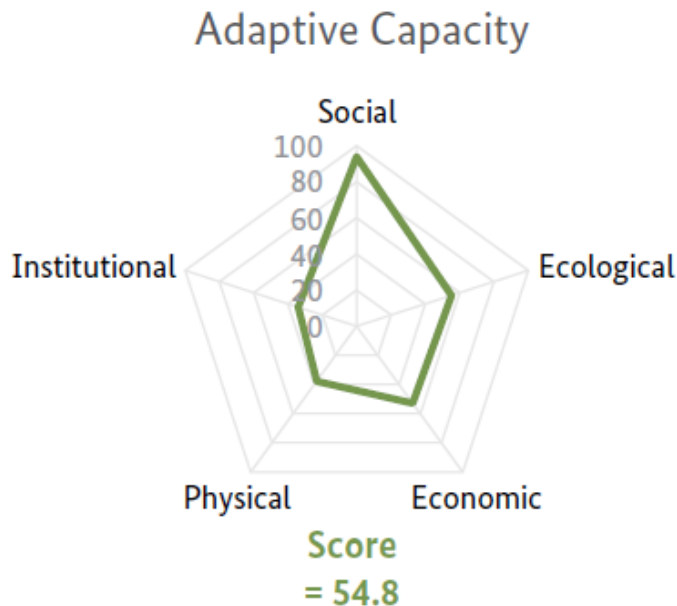
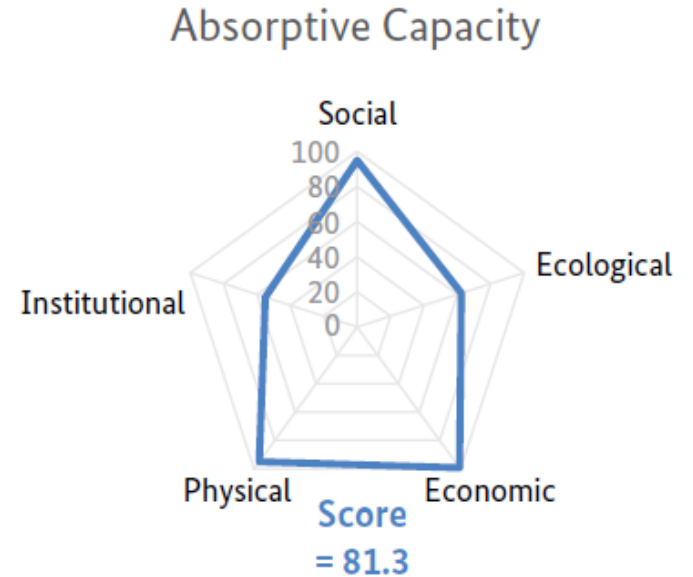
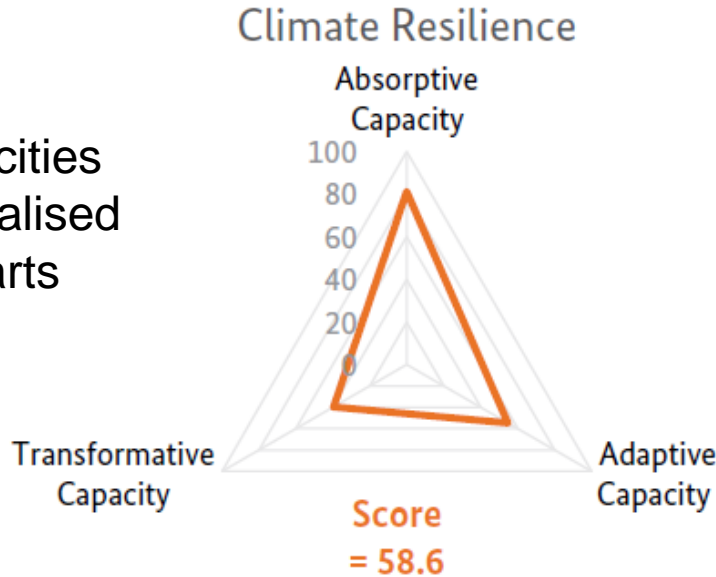
Climate Resilience Indicator Framework

Figure 6 Visualisation of different layers of Mexico's exemplary climate resilience

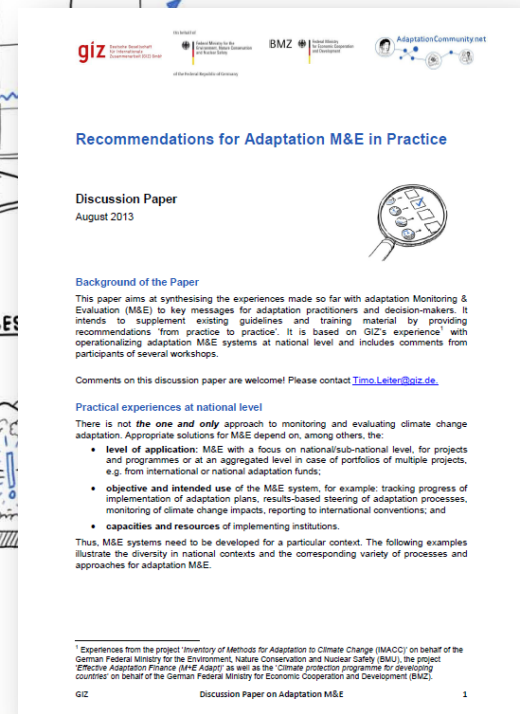
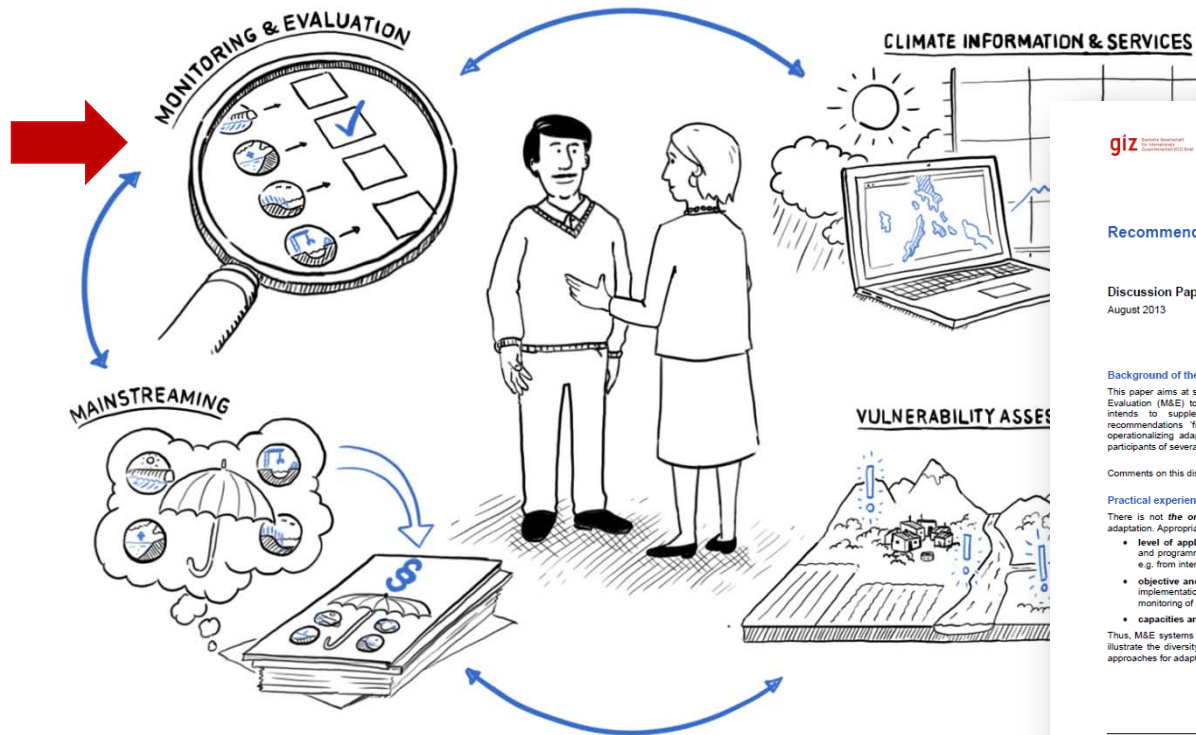
The 3 capacities can be visualised in radar charts (p.10)



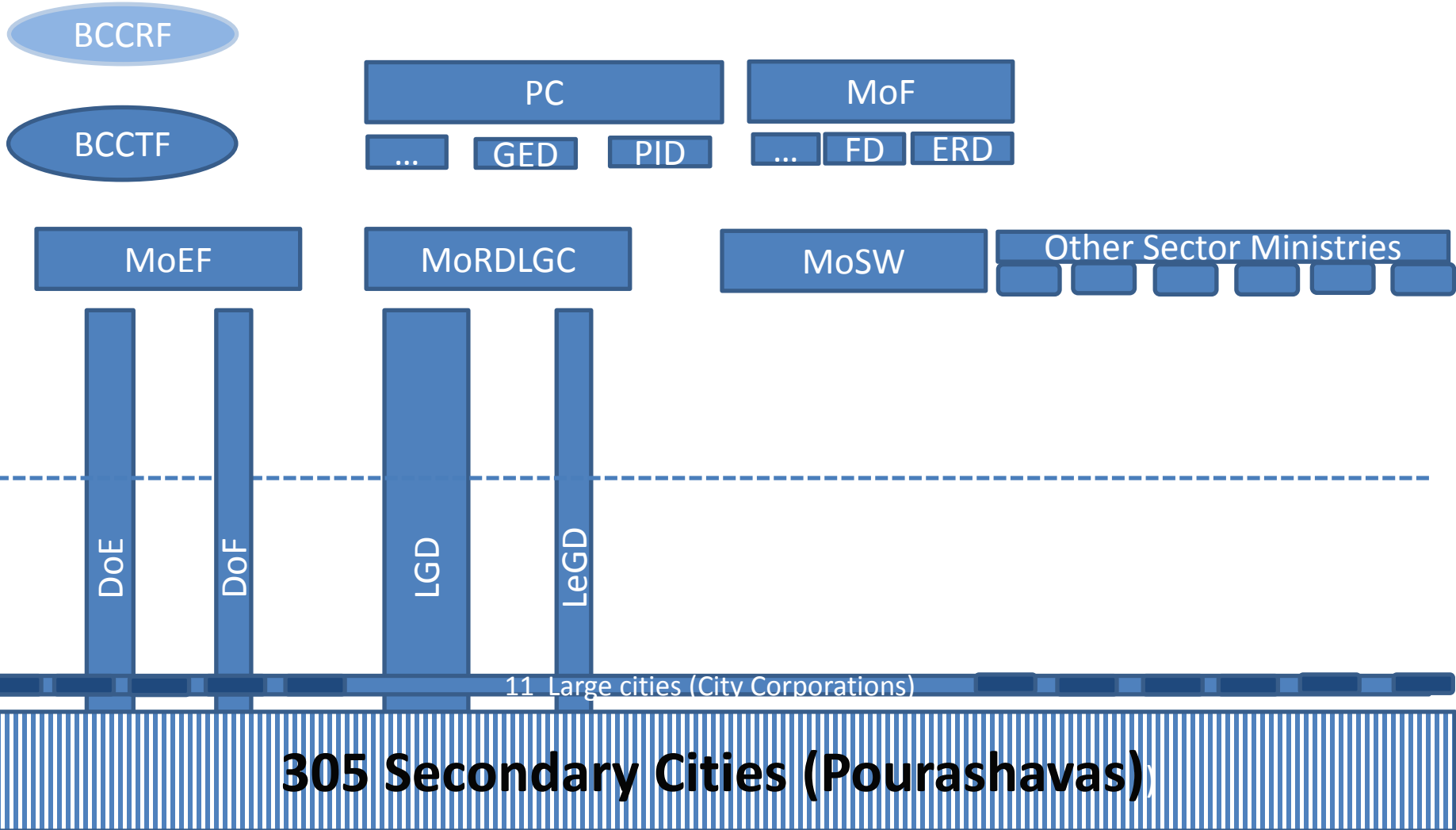

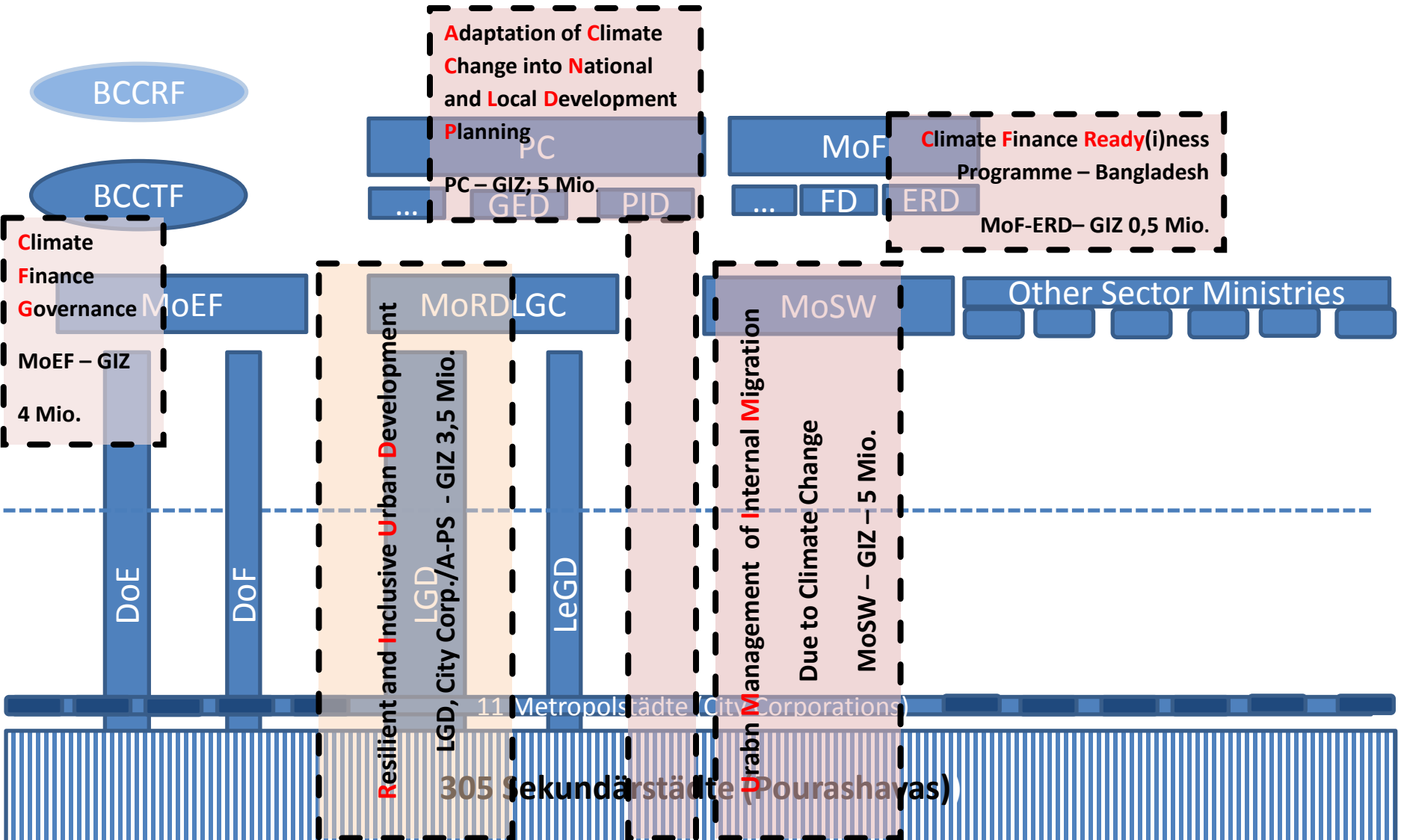
