 - Adaptive/Change management

- Internships in addressing nexus issues
- Enhanced availability of learning material on nexus approaches
- Development of learning tools on how to deal with the increasing level of complexity that comes with higher levels of integration



Question: 7. What education resources are available in the internet and how can they be effectively harnessed and utilized:

World Wide Web is a rich source of learning material. Access to these resources can be enhanced through collaborative knowledge building such as:

- Establishment of learning portals such as CapNet www.cap-net.org/
- Depository of case studies materials such as WoCAT https://www.wocat.net/
- Packaging learning material into small knowledge chunks that can be organized as courses, books as in the case of Connexions - http://cnx.org/



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- 4. More effective search such as Flipboard https://flipboard.com/ - which enables you to read and collect the news you care about and curating your favorite stories into your own magazines on any topic imaginable.
- 5. Packing nexus knowledge base into RSS feeds which allows you to easily stay informed by retrieving the latest content from the sites you are interested in.
