Tracing Knowledge: Mobility, Borders and Visual Arts

The seminar will explore narratives and representations of experiences of migration and mobility through the lens of contemporary visual arts. The main aims of the research are to reflect on and analyse the capacity of contemporary visual arts to create alternative visions and modes of knowledge in relation to experiences of mobility and border representations.

Through the analysis of specific art projects, selected as case studies, the paper investigates the multiplicity of concepts, terms, meanings and feelings, which escape the mainstream narratives and open other flows of knowledge.
