General Editor of Studies in Islamic Philosophy series of Oxford University Press, Dr. Haq recently shared the prestigious Waldo Leland Prize of the American Historical Association for his work in the New Cambridge History of Islam. His writings have appeared in some of the world's top journals; among his publishers are Harvard

University Press, Brill, Blackwell, and Cambridge University Press.
