UNU-GCM responds to the migration crisis in the Mediterranean

Pacific Research Project: UNU-GCM and UNU-EHS Collaboration

Earlier this month, UNU-GCM, together with UNU-EHS, published the main findings of the Pacific Research Project, supported by the Pacific Islands Forum Secretariat. Its policy brief highlights the main human security challenges that climate-induced migrants face in the Pacific when settling in receiving countries or communities and the major reasons for tensions or conflict. In June 2015, the Forum Regional Security Committee of the Pacific Islands Forum Secretariat also considered this research report and in September, the Secretariat asked the States that constitute the Forum to comment on the recommendations that the research team has thus formulated.

UNU Migration Network meeting in Sicily, September 23rd - 26th 2015

Members of the UNU Migration Network gathered to present their latest research findings at the 9th European International Studies Association (EISA) Conference 'The Worlds of Violence', which took place in Sicily from 23rd to 26th September 2015. The presentations formed part of a section on 'International Migration and International Security', organised by Network Coordinator Valeria Bello. Alongside the conference, the UNU Migration Network held its 6th Official Meeting of focal points on Wednesday 23rd September where participants shared updates on policy engagements and research collaborations, and discussed the next phase of Network activities.

UNU-GCM participation in the 'Borderlands' Conference at IBEI

On September 18th 2015, UNU-GCM participated in the 'Borderlands' conference, organized by the students of *IBEI - Institut Barcelona d'Estudis Internacionals*. GCM Director Parvati Nair gave a keynote address on the meaning of community and borders in international relations, and Research Fellow Valeria Bello spoke in a panel on conflict and borders.
