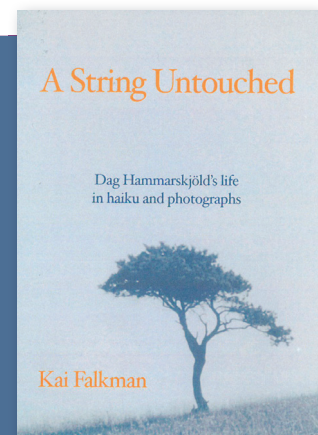

Special Event: 60th Anniversary of Japan's Membership to the UN

Hammar skjöld's Life in Haiku and Photographs



Commemorating the 60th anniversary of Japan's membership to the United Nations, the 23rd UNU Library Talk event will feature haiku and photographs of Dag Hammarskjöld. Swedish-born Hammarskjöld was the second UN Secretary-General, and was a devoted haiku poet, although that became known only after his death in a plane crash in 1961, at the age of 56 and in the midst of his second term as UN Secretary-General. In this event, Kaj Falkman, the author of "*A String Untouched: Dag Hammarskjöld's Life in Haiku and Photographs*" will be joined by Akito Arima and Kit Pancoast Nagamura to explore the world of Hammarskjöld's haiku and photographs.
