**All abstracts must be submitted by e-mail to [sust@unu.edu](mailto:sust@unu.edu)**

- The abstract should not exceed 300 words and must be formatted with 0.75 inch margins all around, 12-pt font size for the narrative text.
- Abstracts must use one of the following serif font styles: Times New Roman, Georgia, Helvetica, or Times.
- The following information must be included in the submitted abstract: presentation title; all author(s)' identifying information, including names and institutional affiliations; narrative text; and 3 to 5 keywords. Narrative text may include tables and/or figures providing the submission stays within the word limit.

- Abstracts must be submitted as PDF files.
- Please use the following naming convention for the file name: Corresponding Author Last Name, First Name\_SSJ.pdf (ex. Basu\_Mrittika\_SSJ.pdf).
